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## WHY SHOULD I COUNT AS I PLAY?

You might hear your teacher say it all the time: "How many beats?" or "Are you counting?" Perhaps you're wondering why counting is so important when playing music. Well, all music is essentially composed of pitch and rhythm. Usually, rhythm is taught either by:

- 1. Math (counting: **1** and **2** and **3** and **4** and)
- 2. Rhythm names (saying syllables like: ta ti-ti)

It's very important to count in music for many reasons. Some of the main reasons are learning how the song should be played if you've never heard it before, or performing with others. Without counting, musicians would never be able to play together because they wouldn't know where they were in the music.

Here are a few ways you can improve your counting, and in doing so, become a better musician!

- Try to FEEL the beat.
  - Clap or pat along to your favourite songs, and if that is easy, then try different time signatures or genres.
- Work on hearing the divisions of the beat.
  - This could be as simple as hearing the eighth note rhythms (ti-ti's) in a song. Hint: if your song has words, you can use that to 'hear' the rhythm.
- Try to WRITE the divisions of the beat.
  - Can you listen to a song and write out the rhythm? Start with simple traditional/folk songs like "Rain Rain Go Away" and work up to more complex music. When you feel like this is going well, try different time signatures!

(Ages 6 months - 4 years)

These Ensembles will be facilitated by two teachers who may assist in all instruments, and help direct the group so as to finish and polish songs.

**Kids Band** is for ages 9-12 years, and runs 5:00PM to 6:30PM. Basic chord recognition is needed, please ask your teacher if this is right for you. **Teen Band** is for ages 12-16 years, and runs 7:00PM to 8:30PM.

Ensembles last four sessions, and students must attend all sessions. The dates are February 1st, 8th, 15th, 22nd. Cost is \$15 per session; \$60 total.
