#### November is Recital Month!

Our students have been practicing diligently for our annual Winter Recital. Our Winter Recital will take place November 28 to December 5, so there are NO REGULAR LESSONS this week!

This year we will have a couple of options for students to perform in front of family and friends. We plan to have our "larger" socially distanced concerts at Trinity Baptist Church (22550 Rd 530) beginning Nov. 28. You will be able to perform live on a big stage, for family and friends!

COVID PROTOCOLS: As per AHS requirements, everyone entering the building will need to be masked; performers under the age of 18 will not need to show proof of vaccination; however, all spectators over the age of 12 and all adult performers will need to show proof of either: double vaccination; negative COVID test; or a medical exemption letter.

This recital will be very similar to our previous recitals except that there will not be a social gathering/reception afterwards and we will have more social distancing (as a result, less people in the audience). These recitals will be held from Sunday, November 28 to Sunday, December 5. Please be prepared to show ID for everyone in your group, including younger students as sometimes it is difficult to determine a child's age.

A smaller concert will be held at Origin Road on Dec. 11 & 12th with a small number of guests (2 or 3) coming with each performer.

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We will also put together a ZOOM recital option where you can either join one of our Origin Road recitals (as above) through ZOOM or we will have a separate ZOOM concert which would be held the weekend of December 10 to 12.

Individual recital dates and times will be announced shorty! We are looking forward to seeing everyone at the Recital!

Introspective and enthralling, with equal parts grit and grace, Emmet Michael is a 23-year old musician who was built on his trials. Emmet has also been a student at Crescendo periodically over the last 4 years and is a well-respected artist in our community.

"We've developed a good working relationship and friendship", he said about working with Leanne Cummings, the studio Owner. "I find with Crescendo, every event is planned with community in mind and events were very catered to my art style. Leanne was very good about pushing me out of my comfort zone with praise and critiques, which I appreciated."

Turning to music in his darkest times, he found solace in his ability to share his heart with others through his lyrics. With soulful melodies and heart-wrenching lyrics, his music conveys a message that is both powerful and vulnerable. Raw vulnerability is what will always set Emmet apart. He bares his soul in a way that is sophisticated far beyond his youth.

When asked about his advice to new musicians, he said, "Disregard any fear about what other people think as it gets in the way of personal progress. It's OK not to be perfect. Mistakes are a great thing!"
